### BIDDING PROCESS

- I. A competitive bidding process has been adopted for the disposal of the properties
- II. Bid forms can be downloaded from the NDLEA website www.ndlea.gov.ng Bid forms must be submitted alongside 10% of the bid amount in Certified Bank Drafts payable to NDLEA. Please note that if the sum exceeds N10 million, multiple certified bank drafts must be provided.
- III. The bid submission must be made in a sealed envelope with "BID FOR PROPERTY "LOT NUMBER" inscribed on the top left corner of the envelope.
- IV. The Certified Bank Drafts of unsuccessful bidders will be returned once the bidding process is concluded.
- V. The successful bidder will be required to pay the 90% outstanding balance of the bid price within 15 working days of the bid submission deadline, failing which the 10% deposit becomes nonrefundable and the properties can be offered to other buyers. Payments shall be made to

- iii. All bidders and/or their representatives are welcome to be present at the bid opening. The highest bid for each property will emerge the winner subject to the highest bid being equal to or above the reserve price. Results will be announced immediately after the conduct of the exercise.
- iii. In the event of a tied bid at the bid opening or where none of the bids match or exceed the reserve price, bidders will be REQUIRED
